Using the Charter Remote for both TV and cable box

- 1) Turn the TV and the cable box on and off using the "System On/Off" button
- 2) Change TV channel one at a time using the up/down rocker or press the number keys for the channel (either three numbers or fewer than 3 and then "OK/Sel" key)
- 3) If you need to control one specific system, press the white button with its type: to tell the remote which one: "CBL" to send commands to the cable box, "TV" for the TV etc. This is useful if you want/need to get to menus, etc.
- 4) To see a listing of what's on, press "Guide" for a scrollable program list

General notes

The remote needs to be pointed at the TV and cable box (sometimes behind the TV) and sends commands one at a time - it takes some time for the commands to get sent, and screens saying "No Input" may briefly show while one system waits for the others.

If there is a problem, start over by turning everything off with "System On/Off", waiting a few seconds and then turning them back on again. Remember to keep the remote pointed at the TV until everything is working, so the remote control signals go in the correct direction.
